1. Using the Powerpoint template provided, tell us the story of your team.
2. One of the slides asks you to share your PCMH-A or MeHAF results. There is a "Scoring Summary" of the PCMH-A (page 15) that you might choose to use. The MeHAF does not have a similar summary page.
3. Once completed, print out your story Powerpoint (one slide per page) and bring it with you to the Kickoff.
4. At the Kickoff you will receive a cardboard tri-fold to attach the pages you have printed to finalize your storyboard and get it ready to display.
5. Be creative and make it your own!
6. During the lunch time we will have a storyboard reception. Other attendees will be circulating and viewing your storyboard. We ask that one person on your team stay with your storyboard to answer any questions. Please rotate this responsibility so all members of your team have a chance to visit the other storyboards.
